Database	Short Summary
CRSP (currently not licensed)	Stock market data; Historical information and market data (such as price, volumes, profits, dividends, historical name data); Daily and monthly closing data (capital market time series)
Moody's Analytics BankFocus	Information on more than 38,000 banks worldwide. Historical information dates back 5 years for listed banks and 3 years for non-listed banks. Content includes: 500 balance and income sheet items (3,000 for US banks), key financial information, information on ownership and subsidiaries, and stock price data.
Refinitiv Eikon/Datastream	Stock prices, market capitalization, dividends, etc. for around 75,000 stocks worldwide including industrial and threshold countries. Over 400,000 international macroeconomic time series with indicators for 215 countries. Exchange rates for 45 countries, over 2,000 interest rates
S&P Capital IQ	Detailed information on company events; includes mergers and takeovers, private equity, venture capital, spin-off, IPOs, bankruptcies, stock buy-back programs, and others; rating information
S&P Compustat (includes Execucomp & Global)	Balance sheet and market data on around 10,000 active and 11,000 non-active US companies as well as around 1,100 Canadian companies
Tick History (currently not licensed)	Global database on financial market trade data and news; particularly important are tick data that are precise down to the millisecond; goes back to January 1996, whereby around 1 million new signals are recorded each second.
WRDS	Internet-based research service for economic data; exploits most extensive sources of finance-, accounting-, economic-, management-, marketing-, banking- and insurance data; offers possibility to modify research results of the integrated databases
